- I confirm that my child has to wear a helmet whilst batting or wicket keeping against a hard ball and must wear other protective equipment.
- I understand that colts membership includes all colts league match fees, and training fees including nets and facilities hire. Additional match fees are payable for adult games.
- I confirm to the best of my knowledge that my son/daughter does not suffer from any medical condition other than those detailed on the medical information form.
- I consent to my child receiving medical treatment which, in the opinion of a qualified medical practitioner, may be necessary.
- I consent to my child participating in matches at other clubs and to travel in transport provided either by officers of the Club, team managers, parents of other youth section members or senior members of the Cricket Club when playing in senior team matches.

- Act as the first point of contact for the reporting of Child Welfare and Protection concerns
- Help and safeguard young people by assisting in the promotion and implementation of the Welfare of Young People Policy at a Club level
- Assist in the raising of awareness of others at the Club in respect of Child Protection
- Be a source of advice and information within the club
- Uphold confidentiality, as far as is practical in all Child Protection matters
- Liaise with the County Welfare Officer when appropriate

Coaches

Club coaches and team managers (qualified or unqualified) have or will have completed a Criminal Record Bureau check. All club members who have regular contact with children will also be asked to have a CRB check. All other members of the club will be asked to complete a Self Declaration Form. Names & contact details of all managers and the Colts Secretary are on the club website.

Club Changing Policy

The club has issued guidelines for changing as it affects junior members. These guidelines are shown below.

The club has applied the following guidelines, which apply to adults and young people (under the age of 16) sharing changing facilities.

1. Adults should try to change and shower at separate times to young players
2. If adults and young players need to share a changing facility, the club must have consent from the parents that their child/children can share a changing room with adults in the club
3. If young people are uncomfortable changing or showering with adults, no pressure should be placed on them to do so. Encourage them to do this at home.

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Code of Conduct



Southgate Compton Cricket Club has produced the following 'Code of Conduct' which outlines the general expectations from the all parties concerned. Southgate Compton Cricket Club expects players, parents, guardians and guests to adhere to this code of conduct as a condition of playing for the club. In the following "you" refers to the players, parents/guardians and any guests.

1. Southgate Compton Cricket Club will provide training and coaching facilities to help colts progress and make most of their potential. Please try to make use of these services whenever possible.
2. Southgate Compton Cricket Club will provide Managers, Umpires, Equipment and Pitches for competitive matches. Please make yourself available for these and make arrangements to attend punctually. When unavailable, please let us know.
3. The best interests of the club and its members and officials should be kept in mind at all time.
4. Team spirit should be encouraged at all times. Any form of victimisation or bullying will not be tolerated.
5. Opponents should always be treated with respect and courtesy with a positive attitude. and abide by the rules of cricket at all time.
6. Umpires, Scorers, Managers, Coaches and other officials give up their time voluntarily and should be respected for their involvement. Dissent or abuse from any persons will not be tolerated. We would encourage you to offer your help and assistance whenever possible.
7. Abusive, Foul, or Aggressive language and or actions will not be allowed in any circumstances.
8. Southgate Compton Cricket Club will ensure all officials main objective will be the best interests of the Club and the Players and expect you to encourage respect for the decisions made to meet those objectives
9. Southgate Compton Cricket Club will provide equipment for matches and training and expect you to respect that equipment and be responsible for it whilst it is in your control.
10. A sensible dress code should be adopted for players on and off the field with whites being worn for games where possible.
11. For safety reasons items of jewellery (e.g. watches, necklaces, bracelets, rings, ear-rings etc) should not be worn whilst playing or training.
12. Southgate Compton Cricket Club cannot be responsible for any lost or damaged property and ask that you take your own protection against such losses.
13. Applause and praise should be kept to a sensible level and that no instruction should be given to anyone on the field of play. Leave all such instruction to the captain or manager.
14. The decisions of any official should not be questioned. Any issues arising should be raised to Colts Secretary, Chairman or Secretary of the Club.
15. Subscriptions, match fees or monies due should be paid promptly.
16. League rules prohibit players from playing for different clubs in the same season. Please discuss with the Colts Secretary any issues with this rule.
17. Team selection and playing decisions will be at the absolute discretion of the managers, officials and captains of the club.
18. It is understood that any breach of conduct that is serious or persistent will be dealt with by dismissal from the club. No guarantee of compensation or future re-instatement can be given.
19. Southgate Compton Cricket Club fully supports and adheres to the ECB "Safe Hands" policy in relation to the Welfare of Young People in Cricket.
20. Use of digital cameras and mobile phones is not allowed in dressing rooms or the shower area. Photography is used within the club to promote and record events such as cricket matches and social events, which may be used on the club website. By signing the application form you give your consent to such activity. If however, you are unhappy with any photo, please let us know and we shall remove the item.
21. Transportation is not provided and any arrangements for such shall be deemed to be done as a 'friend' being given permission basis for such transport provision.

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
