History & Overview

Southgate Compton Cricket Club was formed as the result of a merger between Southgate County Old Boys and Compton cricket clubs in 1970. Southgate County was a school based in Fox Lane, Southgate open between September 1910 and July 1960 when it moved to Sussex Way, Cockfosters as Southgate School.

The club lies on the borders of Barnet, Herts and Middx all within reasonable distance of the club's ground and clubhouse which is situated close to the Cockfosters tube at Hadley Field. We have our own pavilion with changing facilities and a bar. The club is part of an umbrella organisation called SOSA (Southgate Old Scholars Association) who are responsible for running the bar and maintaining the clubhouse. Other member clubs are Southgate County Football Club (adult football), Chase Side Youth Football Club (junior football) and Southgate Compton Table Tennis club.

We currently run 2 Saturday Sides who play in the Saracens Hertfordshire League. The 1st XI is in division 6 and the 2nd XI is in division 10. On Sundays we run one side on a regular basis plus enter a team in the Herts Development Division (where a minimum of 7 players must be under 17).

We put out a Veterans XI about 4 times a season. There is one mid-week match each year against Enfield Police. There is an annual tour to Devon which has been going for over 40 years, playing 4 fixtures against such sides as Seaton, Kilmington, Chard and Ottery. We stay at the "Seaton Heights" hotel.

We run 3 colts sides aged under 11s, under 13s and under 15s who play in the Middlesex Colts League as well as friendly matches. We offer an extensive coaching and training program during both the summer and winter months. The club currently charge a fixed colts membership fee per year and this covers the match fees for all the colts games as well as the coaching sessions, winter nets and social functions.

Social events are organised regularly at the clubhouse such as quizzes, discos, games nights, and barbecues. Our annual awards dinner is held in late October after the season.

A yearly subscription is payable plus a match fee for each match played, covering the cost of playing plus tea.

A newsletter is issued every week during the Summer with reports, news and teamsheets for the following week. This will normally be emailed to you, although special arrangements can be made to have it posted. An availability sheet should be completed and returned to the Team Secretary. If you do not receive confirmation that you are playing by the Thursday before the weekend, contact the Team Secretary. If you have been selected but find you are unable to play please call the Team Secretary as soon as possible so that a replacement can be found.
